Resolution on: Funding Guidelines associated with the Co-sponsorship form

Prime Sponsor(s): Senator Wooleyhand

Committee: Finance

WHEREAS, The current Funding Guidelines are ambiguous, generally create confusion and do not effectively permit an applicant from requesting supplemental funds between September and mid-November;
