1 **Fossil Fuel Divestment** 2 Resolution # FA - 04-15 3 Resolution on: Supporting USM's divestment of fossil fuels and the investment of renewable energy. 4 5 6 Prime Sponsor(s): Senator Smith-Brown 7 Cosponsor(s): Senator Edegbe, Senator Laury, Senator Malik 8 Committee: N/A 9 WHEREAS, The hazardous effects of climate change negatively impact the lives and livelihoods of people 10 11 worldwide and could potentially for those of future generations: and, 12 WHEREAS, The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change Fifth Assessment Report proves that, due to 13 the role of human activity, the warming of earth's climate is unequivocal and rising at 14 15 unprecedented/rapid rates; and, 16 WHEREAS, Fossils fuels emit an overwhelming portion of greenhouse gas emissions, degrading our land, 17 air, and water resources, condemning future generations; and, 18 19 WHEREAS, Climate change will exacerbate environmental defects, water scarcity, food insecurity, and 20 21 regional conflicts; and, 22 WHEREAS, Due to the recent outperformance of broader markets compared to fossil fuels, the rapid 23 decreasing costs of alternative energy forms, the fluctuation of oil prices, and the projected stricter 24 emissions regulations on nonrenewable energy extraction and production, investing long term into the 25 26 fossil fuel industry may pose as a financial threat. 27 THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT: 28 29 SECTION 1. We will urge Chancellor Caret to freeze all investments in fossil fuel companies, sell 30 off/divest those investments within five years, and reinvest in clean renewable energy companies upon 31 32 selling those assets. 33 SECTION 2. As the University System of Maine, Stanford, Georgetown, and 39 other universities/colleges 34 who have pledged to partially or fully divest their institutions from fossil fuel companies, to truly ensure 35 a better future for all University System of Maryland students, the University System of Maryland must 36 divest its endowment fund from the fossil fuel industry. 37 38
