WHEREAS: The Student Government Association does not currently have a committee which is dedicated to planning special events on campus,

WHEREAS: In anticipation of the University of Baltimore campus reopening in the near future, SGA plans to plan a special “UBalt is Back Festival” for the end of Spring 2022 semester where we will invite all current students, alumni and greater community to join us for a special celebration of our resilience and collective work to overcome the pandemic.

WHEREAS: Organizing an event of this magnitude requires a great deal of planning which can only be efficiently done within a committee solely dedicated to serve this purpose,

WHEREAS: SGA will reach out to Student Events Board (SEB) and Student Bar Association (SBA) to create a proposal for this event.

WHEREAS: This committee will present a formal proposal to the SGA at the end of September/beginning of October to secure additional allocations funding.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED:

Sections One: The University of Baltimore Student Government Association Senate formally establishes the creation of an Ad-Hoc Special Events Committee for the academic year 2021-2022.

SECTION Two: The Ad-Hoc Special Events Committee shall be responsible for the planning and realization of special events for students at the University of Baltimore.

SECTION Three: This committee is empowered to collaborate with other campus organizations as well as host community conversations to incorporate feedback about event planning,

SECTION Four: Executive Vice President Sabrina Bridglal will be appointed to lead this committee as chair.
