Resolution on: Indigenous Peoples' Day.

WHEREAS, Indigenous peoples' role in history has been overlooked and misrepresented; and

WHEREAS, Cities and universities have been adopting Indigenous Peoples' Day since 1992; and

WHEREAS, The acknowledgment of Indigenous Peoples' Day will promote culture, diversity, and the true history of the United States.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:

SECTION 1. The University of Baltimore will acknowledge October 9th, 2017 as Indigenous Peoples' Day.

SECTION 2. The University of Baltimore will acknowledge every second Monday of October as Indigenous Peoples' Day.

SECTION 3. Every year, on the second Monday of October, the SGA will be promoting and adopting Indigenous Peoples' Day as a holiday.
