**WHEREAS,** Information presented to the SGA by the Director of the Student Center and Recreation Programs offers a compelling reason to close the Student Center on Sundays.


**THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:**

The SGA supports the proposed modifications in the hours of availability for the Student Center.


**SECTION 2.**
