WHEREAS: The last time The University of Baltimore conducted a Campus Climate Survey was in 2016, which was over 5 years ago,

WHEREAS: The current climate environment is very different as since the last Campus Climate Survey the school has undergone many changes,

WHEREAS: Our data based on which we make decisions needs to be relevant and current so we are not basing our decisions on outdated information,

WHEREAS: There is a big benefit of doing a Campus Climate Survey, which is knowing current perspectives of students regarding numerous important issues related to our campus climate and culture,

WHEREAS: According to the National Association of Diversity Officers in Higher Education, campus climate surveys should be conducted every two to three years in order to have relevant information about campus culture and problems that have arisen,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED:

Sections One: The University of Baltimore SGA is formally requesting the University of Baltimore to conduct a campus climate survey during the 2021-2022 academic year in order to make appropriate campus decisions that are in line with the needs and lived experiences of our campus community.

Section Two: The University of Baltimore SGA is requesting the University of Baltimore to conduct a formal presentation of the results of the survey upon completion and have the information easily available to the campus community.

Section Three: The University of Baltimore SGA is formally requesting the University of Baltimore to conduct a campus climate survey every three years thereafter.
