Resolution on: Formation of Undergraduate Syllabus Bank Ad-hoc Committee

WHEREAS, Students have expressed a need to have information about courses prior to registration; and,

WHEREAS, University of Baltimore School of Law has an existing Syllabus Bank; and,

WHEREAS, The ALC has some syllabi available for tutoring purposes; and,

WHEREAS, Student retention rates are lower than expected; and,

WHEREAS, A Syllabus Bank increases students' academic performance by providing course expectations in advance.

THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:

SECTION 1. An Ad-hoc Committee be formed to further research impacts and implementation of a University-wide Syllabus Bank; and,

SECTION 2. Committee will be comprised of students and members that represent each of the three schools (Arts and Sciences, Business, Public Affairs), faculty, staff, and Student Government Association representatives
