WHEREAS, as previously stated in Resolution #14, The University of Baltimore has had a steadily declining student life and campus culture that is in desperate need of revival,

WHEREAS, similarly as previously stated in Resolution #14, The number of non-law student organizations on campus has fallen dramatically in the past 4 years, and the Center for Student Engagement and Inclusion has not been able to successfully maintain a growing, active, and exciting campus culture due to budgetary reasons and the COVID-19 pandemic,

WHEREAS, Student Life is an integral part of a university's identity and campus culture because it helps build school spirit and morale amongst students and faculty/staff as well as providing a sense of connection to the school for all students that have attended the institution,

WHEREAS, in order to solve a such campus crisis, SGA strongly believes that it would be best to create

THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED:

SECTION 1: The University of Baltimore SGA recommends Center for Student Engagement and Inclusion and Division for Student Life and Support to work collaboratively and creation of a taskforce within the division comprised of Students, Staff and Faculty to meet to discuss the decline in student life and find ways to not only reengage students with campus activities post COVID-19 Pandemic but to bring new opportunities to make student life better for all UBalt Students.

SECTION 2: SGA recommends the universities CSEI office to run a process where our campus community collectively has some type of input on what and how student engagement will look post pandemic and in the near future.

SECTION 3: The University of Baltimore SGA will share this resolution with the Faculty Senate, Staff Senate, SBA, GSC, Provost Anderson, Vice President Nicole Morano and President Schmoke to start a discussion about this topic and to gain feedback from a wide population regarding possible ideas.
