**Resolution on:** Development of an Anthropology Minor at UB

**WHEREAS,** The University of Baltimore offers an array of Anthropology courses but does not currently have an Anthropology degree; and,

**WHEREAS,** There are students who are interested in Anthropology that would like to be recognized for the anthropology classes they have taken; and,

**WHEREAS,** Having a minor in Anthropology would allow students to show their accomplishments; and,

**WHEREAS,** Having an Anthropology minor could potentially pave the way toward the future implementation of an Anthropology major at the university.

**THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** An Anthropology minor be created and offered at the University of Baltimore.

**SECTION 2.** Based upon the requirements for other minors and the Anthropology courses currently offered at UB, recommendations for the program are as follows:

**Requirements:**

Five Anthropology courses totaling at least fifteen credits (A maximum of six credits could be transferred from other institutions).

**Required courses:**


Cultural Anthropology (ANTH 110)

Anthropological Theory (ANTH 440)

And complete both of the following:

Two ANTH elective courses at the 200 level or higher

One ANTH elective course at the 300 level or higher
