WHEREAS, a strategic enrollment team (SET) has been formed to develop further insights into the future of the freshman program at UB and general university enrollment.


THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT: The SGA be granted membership of specific SGA members (to be later named) on the SET, to ensure proper student representation.

SECTION 1. That the selected members encourage transparency of the SET with the University community.


SECTION 2. That selected members encourage data driven research motivate the outcomes of SET.
