**WHEREAS,** Time during Senate meetings are extremely limited and much business must be done in an expedited fashion. Also the UB student community should be given reasonable time to voice pleasure or displeasure to the legislation and receive feedback afterward before a vote is brought forth.

**WHEREAS,** The new Sakai page allows the possibility for more transparency in the Senate. This is an opportunity to further take advantage that.

**THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** All Bills and Resolutions, that have been passed, shall be placed on the Sakai Board for easy access to everyone in the Senate as well as all members of the University of Baltimore Family student body. It is to shall be continually updated and organized in a chronological fashion.

**SECTION 2.** Upon completion of granting full access, of the SGA Sakai page, to all members of the Student Body, all Bills and Resolutions that are going to be put up to a vote shall first be introduced on Sakai at least one week prior to being introduced into the Senate. Allowing for immediate and Productive feedback and discussion from both Senators and Constituents. This introduction to Sakai Shall supplant the traditional method of introducing a Bill or Resolution to the Senate and voting on it The following week.

**SECTION 3.** Managers of the Sakai Page responsible for upkeep are to be responsible the upkeep entailed in Lines 18 through 20, Section 1 of this Resolution. They are also given the liberty of how to go about implementing this resolution to maintain an organized Sakai Page.
