9 10	WHEREAS, The University of Baltimore Student Government Association (UBSGA) Constitution has	
11	revealed, throughout the 2013-2014 academic year, there are many problems which have stifled the	
12	efficiency and functionality of the SGA. The constitution has failed to provide clarification on major	
13	issues that could have solved disputes swiftly and it has created an environment of uncertainty which	
14	affects the members of the SGA Senate and Executive Board.	
15		
16	WHEREAS, The UBSGA Constitution has created unintended loopholes, that pose a threat to the	
17	integrity of the SGA. Where common sense ideas would have passed and upheld the constitution tied	
18	the Senate's hands.	
19	THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:	
20 21	THEREFORE LET IT BE ENACTED THAT:	
22	SECTION 1. A Workgroup is to be formed, known as the Constitutional Review Committee (CRC). This	
23	committee, which will only be active during the Summer semester of the 2013-2014 academic year, will	
24	be charged with reviewing and editing the current UBSGA Constitution. These changes will be voted	
25	upon by the incoming Senate class and ratified into binding perpetuity henceforth. This vote shall take	
26	place at the last Senate meeting preceding the start of the Fall 2014 semester. Should that meeting be	
27	canceled, the vote will take place at the first subsequent Senate meeting. It will require a 51% majority	
28	vote to take effect. Should the vote fail, the workgroup will continue to address changes and present	
29	them at each subsequent meeting until they are agreed upon by the Senate and voted into effect.  Should there be no consensus by the end of the third meeting of the Senate during the Fall 2014	
30 31	semester, the SGA advisor or Executive Director of Student Development will enact the constitution into	
32	effect until the Summer of 2015 when a new committee must be formed to correct any issues that	
33	prevented ratification within the first three Fall 2014 semester Senate meetings.

35	SECTION 2. The committee will be overseen and chaired by the SGA Advisor, or the Executive Director of	
36	Student Development should the former not be appointed at the time of the first CRC meeting. The	
37	workgroup shall be comprised of nine persons not including the Chair: at least one-third, yet no more	
38	than half, of the committee shall be comprised of student leaders/appointees from other student	
39	groups and past SGA members who are not actively serving the SGA, whereas the rest of the seats shall consist of active SGA members. Of the active SGA members the Vice-President shall be compelled to	
40 41	serve on this workgroup and serve as Vice-Chair. Those persons appointed to the workgroup shall be

Should the CRC 46 not secure ratification by the conclusion of the third Fall 2014 semester Senate meeting, the power to 47 enact into effect will be transferred to the SGA Advisor or the Executive Director of Student 48 Development.
