- **Monday, Mar. 27-Thursday, Apr. 27- Commencement Tickets Available**
 - Must be claimed online through Marching Order during this period.
 - Students will be emailed on Mar. 27 with their specific link to register and claim tickets.
 - There will be an initial allotment of tickets given.
 - Tickets are not guaranteed after this deadline.

- **Thursday, Apr. 6: Deadline to apply for Graduation with Records and Registration for those wishing to participate in Commencement.**
 - You have all submitted your application to graduate. Your UB portal will state, 'Program in Review', 'Needs to Finish Pending Work', or 'Applied for Graduation' at this time.
 - If you submitted your application and your status says 'Denied' you will need to inquire with your advisor. Commencement Appeals (for students requesting to participate in a different commencement term) open March 6-April 6. Form can be found here- <https://cglink.me/2g3/s18420>
- **Thursday, Apr. 6: Deadline to submit Commencement Information Form to document name spelling for program and reading at Commencement, honor society participation, or Military status. Honor society and military status will be confirmed on campus.**

Important Reminders for Graduates:

- Make sure your accounts are cleared – pay any outstanding bills through the Bursar- <http://www.ubalt.edu/about-ub/offices-and-services/bursar/index.cfm>.
- Return books to the library, if transcripts are required from other school at which you took a class, make sure they get to the Office of Records and Registration.
- Double check your address on the MyUB portal. Once final grades are posted, classes are reviewed, honors determined, accounts checked, etc., through the Office of Records and Registration, your degree will be ordered and sent directly to the local address as noted on MyUB. This process usually takes between six and eight weeks.
- After the ceremony, extra programs are available. Visit www.ubalt.edu/commencement to request a copy after May 24.
- You have access to the MyUB Portal for two semesters after your last date of enrollment. Network services access (e-mail, labs, Office365, etc.) is also maintained for two semesters after your last date of enrollment. Visit the Student Accounts page
