

Below is the simple two-step process to complete the free Becker Academy diagnostic, along with important context to help you prepare ahead of the meeting.

Step 1: Request free access (14-day trial)

- Visit: <https://www.becker.com/cpa-review/course-demos>
- Request a 14-day trial of the Becker CPA Review course
- **Important:** Access is not instant and is processed manually
- Students should allow up to 2 business days to receive their welcome email and login information

Step 2: Take the Becker Academy Diagnostic

- Once logged in, complete the 30-question Becker Academy Diagnostic.
- After completing the diagnostic, export your results as a PDF.
- Send the PDF to ubbap@ubalt.edu as confirmation that the diagnostic was completed.

Note: Individual or collective diagnostic results will not be reviewed for the presentation.

What students should know before starting

Becker Academy is built for students who are at or near the end of their accounting program. The goal is to help them see what CPA exam prep actually looks like and whether a refresher course in the Becker Academy platform might be helpful before jumping into full CPA Review.

With this in mind, some of the questions may feel unfamiliar, especially if you haven't taken advanced courses yet—that's completely normal. If you don't know an answer, choose "I don't know" instead of guessing. This isn't a test and it's not about your score. Think of this as a check-in, not an evaluation. It's meant to give you clarity on what's ahead and help spark a more real, relevant conversation when Anthony Quintero visits to present about the CPA path.

Make sure you give yourself enough time to register for the trial and complete the diagnostic **by March 3.**
